MENTOR REQUIREMENTS

2023-2024

PARTICIPANTS MEETINGS

- ❖ Mentors are paid \$100 for each session, 45 min-1 hour, preferably at least twice per month. Meetings should be guided by, but not limited to, topics of that month's webinar.
- ❖ Mentors must submit a mentor log for each session, link to Google form will be provided.

WEBINARS AND TRAINING SESSIONS

- ❖ Mentors are expected to listen to each webinar, either live or recorded, to assist their mentee to further explore and implement the information presented.
- ❖ Mentors are required to participate in two professional development sessions specifically for training mentors, which will give you guidance on what to cover throughout the year in your sessions.

OBSERVATIONS

- ❖ At least one observation of mentee teaching is required at least once during the school year; either observing your mentee teaching in their school or giving a model in a chosen school.
- ❖ Other possible observations are strongly recommended but not required:
 - Remote mentoring: coordinate a live zoom or watch a recorded video of your mentee teaching
 - Have your mentee observe you teaching
 - Facilitate the opportunity for your mentee to observe other teachers

CONFERENCES:

- ❖ Mentors are invited to attend two-three live conferences, dates and locations to follow.
- ❖ Attending at least one conference is mandatory. If necessary, travel expenses to conferences will be partially covered by CoJDS.

OTHER INFORMATION:

- ❖ As a mentor, you are part of the CoJDS staff, and are expected to provide written reports and answer surveys in a timely fashion throughout the year.
- ❖ Each mentor is required to participate in a Zoom interview with CoJDS staff before finalizing employment.
- ❖ The Lilmod U'lilamed program is invested in your career and in building teachers and school leaders. If you are interested in transitioning into a role in school administration at any point in your career, CoJDS is actively involved in school placements.
